Deciphering microbial diversity and function in the environment through Next Generation Sequencing

CNR-ISMAR in Venice, Italy - October 6 -10, 2014

HOW TO REACH THE VENUE

The 5th ICME course will be held at the laboratories of the Institute of Marine Sciences of the National Research Council (**CNR-ISMAR**) located in the historical centre of Venice, in the **Arsenale** area (**45°26'15.2"N - 12°21'19.0"E**).

1) From either the **railway station (Venezia Santa Lucia**, corresponding to the bus stop FERROVIA) or the **bus terminal (Piazzale Roma)** take the **vaporetto line 5.2** until the **stop Celestia** or **Bacini** (ask onboard that you want to stop there). Both stops are fine. From the boat stop to the ISMAR-CNR it is then a five minute walk. We will put convenient signs showing the way to the Institute. Departures from Venezia Santa Lucia and Piazzale Roma are every 30 minutes, the vaporetto trip will take about 30 minutes. The fare is 7 euro (each way). If you plan to take vaporetto everyday, take into consideration the travel card options. More information at:

2) From either the **railway station (Venezia Santa Lucia**, corresponding to the bus stop FERROVIA) or the **bus terminal (Piazzale Roma)** it may be possible to reach the Institute. It is a **35-40 minutes walk**.

3) By **walk from the Biennale area** or the renowned **Via Garibaldi** (heart of the Castello district): follow the direction on the map below. It is an enjoying **15-20 minutes walk**. If you get lost on the way ... ask people how to go the Celestia vaporetto stop or the "Tese of Arsenale".
